Northern Colorado Chapter Fact Sheet – FY2009 Statistics

The Northern Colorado Chapter of the American Red Cross serves the entire upper third of the state from Moffat County in the northwest to Sedgwick County in the northeast, including Ft. Collins, Greeley, Ft. Morgan, Sterling, Steamboat Springs and Craig.

During the 2009 fiscal year (July 2008-July 2009), Northern Colorado Chapter:

- Served 142 individuals affected by disasters, primarily fires.
- Participated in three joint emergency response exercises
- Provided support in 528 Service to Armed Forces cases, including 208 cases where the Red Cross provided emergency communications to deployed members of the military.
- Trained 380 individuals in caregiving (e.g. babysitting)
- Taught 7,331 individuals in aquatics classes (learn-to-swim and lifeguarding)
- Trained 12,029 individuals in First Aid, CPR and/or AED.
